

FARM'IN Moves Toward Its Final Milestones

The FARM'IN project is now entering its final stage, building on the progress achieved through the implementation of training activities in the partner countries. Following the first “Train-the-Operators” sessions carried out in Greece and the operator training activities implemented in Slovenia, the partnership is continuing its work to consolidate results, support knowledge transfer, and prepare the final presentation of the project’s achievements. This phase is especially important, as it connects the practical delivery of the training courses with the wider objective of creating a replicable and innovative vocational education and training model for social farming.

Throughout the project, FARM'IN has focused on improving the quality and innovation of VET in the field of social farming through a structured process that included mapping the state of the art in Italy, Greece, and Slovenia, developing dedicated training tools for both trainers and operators, and applying innovative teaching methods and materials. These steps have helped create a solid foundation for strengthening professional skills, promoting social inclusion, and supporting more sustainable and inclusive agricultural practices across the participating countries.

The knowledge acquired by trainers and operators, as well as the collaboration established among organisations from Italy, Greece, and Slovenia, represent a meaningful contribution to the promotion of social farming at European level. The upcoming final stage will provide an opportunity to share the project’s main results, reflect on lessons learned and explore how these outcomes can continue to support inclusion through social farming in the future.
